## **What it looks like for YOU when you attend an MDS class**

### **SCREENING**

- All students will be verbally screened by MDS staff or volunteers for symptoms prior to entering the premises.
- Parent & mature student volunteers greatly appreciated in some class transitions with screening. Contact Miss Maria 541-252-1394
- Students not yet comfortable, may join their class from home using their teachers ZOOM ID. Please message your teachers if that service is needed on a given day.

### **CLASS PROCEDURES**

- Discuss with your child, that social distancing will be required to participate. Our studios are marked with 6' spacing for all parts of the class. Instructors will give directions.
- Students and staff may wear cloth, paper, or disposable face coverings, however, they are not required per the guidelines.
- Students will be given hand sanitizer before class or will be allowed to wash their hands for 20 seconds if allergic to sanitizer.
- All students must arrive in uniform with their own equipment.
- No loaner uniforms or shoes will be available.
- Bring a bag to hold street shoes & other personal items. This will help us with faster class to class transitions.
- Waiting room will not be available during phase 1 without prior reservation. Otherwise, only students in the class hour may be present in the building. We ask that parents not enter the facility.
- Tuition will resume, but only for the classes that families re-commit to and are made available. This will be in effect for both in-person or zoom participants starting May 18.
- Large classes over the studio maximum may be asked to alternate weeks. Example: week 1 & 3 Sally participates in class at MarLo facility and by zoom on weeks 2 & 4. This is unlikely, but is an in-place plan if needed.



## **STAFF CLASSROOM TEACHING PROCEDURES**

During Phase 1 here is what STAFF is doing:

**STUDIO A: Maximum Capacity 10 plus 1 teacher**

**STUDIO B: Maximum Capacity 6 plus 1 teacher**

1. Every dancer entering must be screened:
  - a. "Have you had a new or worsening cough?"
  - b. "Have you had a fever?"
  - c. If yes, they must be sent home immediately. A contact list is provided in both studios.
2. Both studios are marked with barre positions measured 6 feet apart.
  - a. Between barre & center the instructor will indicate individual students one by one to an assigned center positions.
  - b. Staff/aides: will maintain 6' distancing from students or wear a mask when not possible.
3. Both studios are marked with center positions 6 feet apart.
  - a. For large movement, teachers may direct majority of class to return to barre positions while 1 or 2 students (maintaining distance) execute larger movement.
  - b. Siblings do not need to distance.
4. Class Spacing:
  - a. Maintain normal class start times, however end times may adjust by 5 minutes for sanitizing and screening. As we practice this function, it will go faster.
  - b. Students will exit studio A through the emergency exit for traffic flow.
  - c. Studio B entrants must wait for the GREEN OPEN SIGN to turn from the ORANGE WAIT before entering. Successive classes will wait outside the facility in their cars or 6' apart outside.



## **CLEANING PROCEDURES BETWEEN CLASSES**

### Staff Equipment

At end shift of either studio, instructor, using sanitation wipes, will wipe down: teacher's table, stereo, remotes, cords.

### Facility & Student Equipment between classes

Beginning of each class assign aides or mature students to use sanitation wipes (with gloves on) wipe down all of the following after class:

Barres

Doorknobs/Windows pulls/Fan controls

Waiting room

There will be no loaner shoes or loaner clothing available.

All waiting room toys and books will be removed during Phase 1.

Limited use of classroom props. All props will be sanitized after use.

Bathroom will be thoroughly sanitized prior to opening everyday.
